

## ATMs for Sudan

OMDURMAN NATIONAL BANK (ONB) in Sudan has launched the nation's first ATMs. The bank now has rolled out their first 10 ATMs in Khartoum, and will roll out a further 12 throughout the country including Port Sudan and Wad Medini.

ONB has licensed BankWorld ATM Client, Controller and Distributor. ATM Client allows ONB brand its ATMs in the same manner as other channels. BankWorld Controller provides ATM fault diagnostics thus reducing maintenance call-out costs. With BankWorld Distributor, ATM administration is streamlined by allowing software updates to be executed remotely and at a time that the ATMs are least likely to be in use. The bank also signed a further contract for a point of sale terminal management system to run alongside the existing BankWorld solution. This will allow the bank's customers to pay for goods and services using their ATM debit card.
