Swift has appointed James P. Donovan (*left*) as head of its securities industry division and member of the executive committee. Prior to this, Donovan was securities executive at

Citigroup. He replaces Francis Remacle who will retire later this year.

Morgan Stanley has appointed Eileen Murray as head of global operations and technology effective 21st October. Murray joined Credit Suisse First Boston in 2002 as head of global technology, operations and product control and managed over 7000 professionals. She was appointed to the firm's divisional committee and was the first woman to serve on CSFB's executive board. Prior to joining CSFB, Murray spent 18 years at Morgan Stanley, attaining the position of managing director.

Jeremy Goddard, former managing director and owner of Symtec Solutions and latterly head of **Bankserv International** in the UK (Bankserv acquired Symtec a couple of years ago) has departed. In his place comes Mary Ellen Putnam who has been named vice president and international business unit manager. Formerly, Putnam was with Stratus Technologies where she served as director of corporate banking technologies.

S1 Corporation has appointed its co-founder and chairman James Mahan as CEO, replacing Jaime Ellertson. Mahan originally served as CEO from 1995 to 2000 before being replaced by Ellertson. The company has not disclosed the reason behind Ellertson's departure.
